According to our raw material suppliers, the raw materials used in the manufacture of Polymeric US inks/adhesives are not expected to contain Bisphenol A at detectable levels in any of our standard ink lines, including the following:

Additionally, the Imagemark XR and Dualcure DC inklines were tested by a third-party lab (ANSECO) on February 1, 2016 and passed the Total Bisphenol A (BPA) Content evaluation.

According to ANSECO there is no requirement for retesting providing there has not been a formulation or raw-material change. These products have not been re-formulated and all raw materials are original spec.

If certification is required, a third-party test lab can be recommended by our Technical Services Department.
